

2018 Louisiana Remote Sensing and GIS Workshop

Student Poster Competition!

Students are encouraged to submit posters depicting their work from class projects, thesis or dissertation work, or individual research.

Guidelines:

- Posters should clearly define a research study, map, coursework-related project, personal interest, or other process which incorporates geographic science and technology
- Students may submit one poster for the competition
- Students must bring a printed copy for display at the workshop
- Posters should be no larger than 42" x 60"
- Presenters will be provided with an easel and foam core board
- All poster presenters must be registered before the poster is displayed
- Abstracts and a digital version of the poster must be submitted by midnight May 1, 2018

Judging and Awards:

- Posters will be judged on scientific and technical merit, effective design and use of cartographic principals, & overall impression/quality of work
- Student posters will be judged by a panel of experienced geographic information specialists during the LA RSGIS workshop
- Students must be present during judging to answer questions
- Cash prizes will be awarded: \$200 First, \$100 Second, \$50 Third place poster.
- Contest winners will be announced during the awards ceremony
